## Application for travel funding

Post doc Åsa Ståhl and postdoc Kristina Lindström have applied for travel funding for participating in a pre-workshop at the 4S conference in Denver, Colorado, USA. The aim of the pre-conference workshop is to produce a special issue of *Limn*, a critically engaged, public facing and design conscious venue dedicated to exploration, provocation, and new scholarly expression around issues of contemporary importance (for more on *Limn* and examples of past issues, see: <http://limn.it>). They have received travel grants from Digital Information Technologies Program at the Sloan Foundation, partners at the University of Washington. The application to UID concerns conference fee and accommodation.

The Research council suggests that applications for travel grants to a total of 40 000 SEK from the Travel funding at UID should be granted for Åsa Ståhl and Kristina Lindström.

Notable is that the Research council make this suggestion as a particular case since current guidelines not seems to cover present needs and situation at UID.

However, research council discussed current guidelines for travel applications and suggests that a group from the Research council should look into the guidelines and adjust them to the actual situation at UID.
