Monica is telling us about the importance of wearing a helmet on your head and lights on your bike when you are biking in Umeå. It is also a good idea to buy wintertires. And remember to use reflexes – both on your bike and on yourself!

3. Work injuries/accidents and incidents

Titti tells about the procedure of reporting work injuries/accidents and incidents.

As a student at Umeå University you are insured during your studies and on your way to or from UID. If you are injured – or experience something that could have resulted in an injury – you should report this to the school, preferably a person in the EHS group/work environment group. In relation to this you can apply for compensation from the insurance company. This is so we can keep track of the accidents/incidents and try to prevent them from happening. We are also obligated to report this to Umeå University every year.



4. Scholarship: Brita-Stina Nordenstedt

Ingela tells about the Brita-Stina Nordenstedt scholarship, which is mainly for thesis projects, but could also be used for competitions, travel or attendance at conferences and symposia. Students enrolled at Umeå Institute of Design, the Umeå School of Technology and Department of Nutritional Sciences can apply.
